Visit Guidelines

- Visitors should always use the authorized roads, trails and paths indicated. Driving outside of designated areas is strictly prohibited.
- Visitors should help protect the environment by placing trash in appropriate receptacles.
- Excessive noise is considered a source of contamination as well; please be respectful of your neighbors and keep noise to a minimum
- Please respect local flora and fauna: it is prohibited to take or disturb plants and wildlife.
- Help us avoid fires: smoking is prohibited and littering of cigarette butts in the environment is strictly forbidden.
- The **PUNTACANA Ecological Foundation** will not be held responsible for any accidents that may occur during unguided visits.
- The **PUNTACANA Ecological Foundation** reserves the right to deny access and/or expel any person whose behavior is not considered appropriate.

Rules for Indigenous Eyes Ecological Reserve

- The use of coolers and glass bottles is NOT permitted.
- Visitors are only allowed to swim in the lagoons that have a stairs leading into the water: Yauya, Cacibajagua, Inriri, Guama and Yocachu.
- Appropriate and adequate swim wear is required for visitors who wish to swim in the lagoons.
- Use of life preservers is recommended for all young children and adults who are not good swimmers.

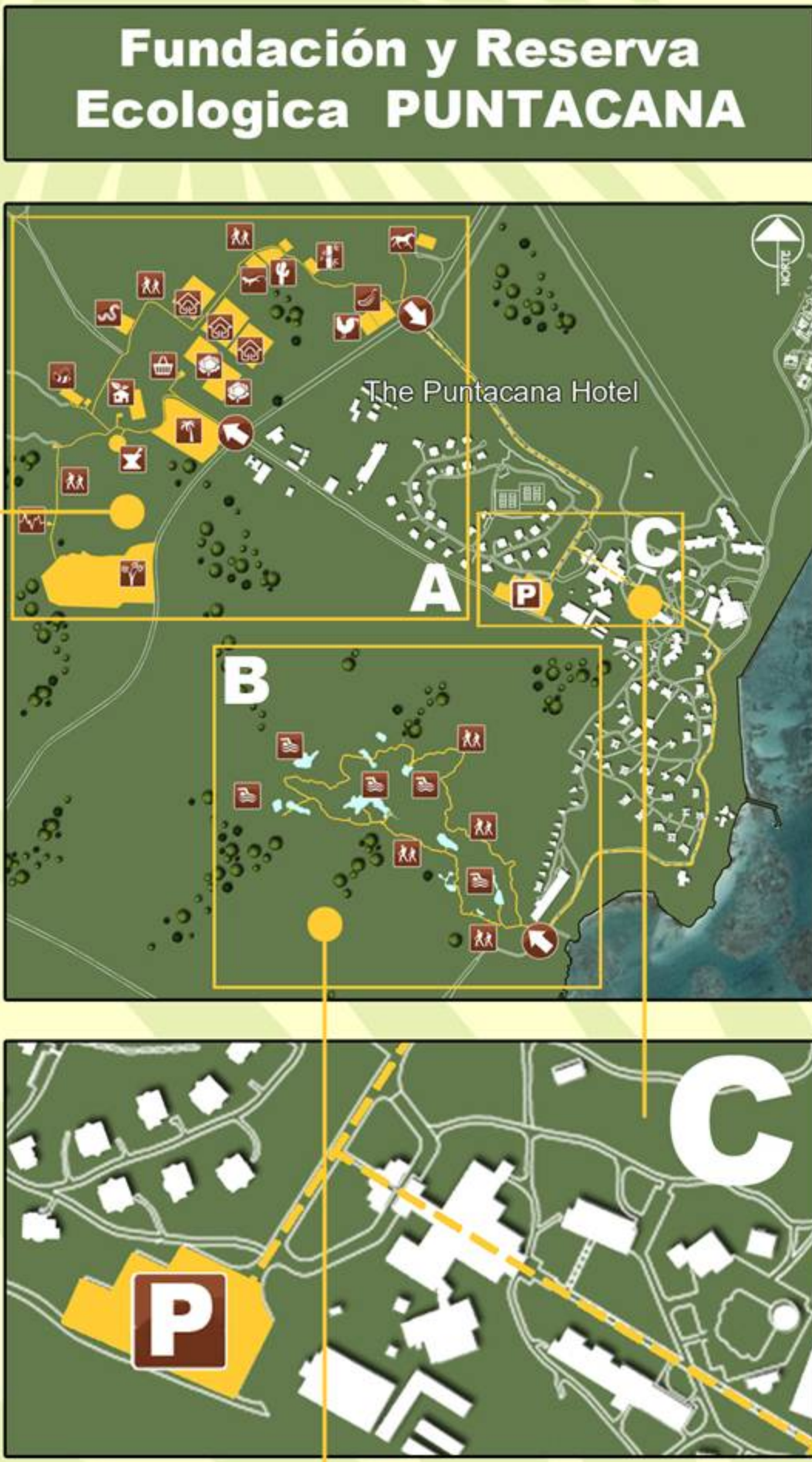
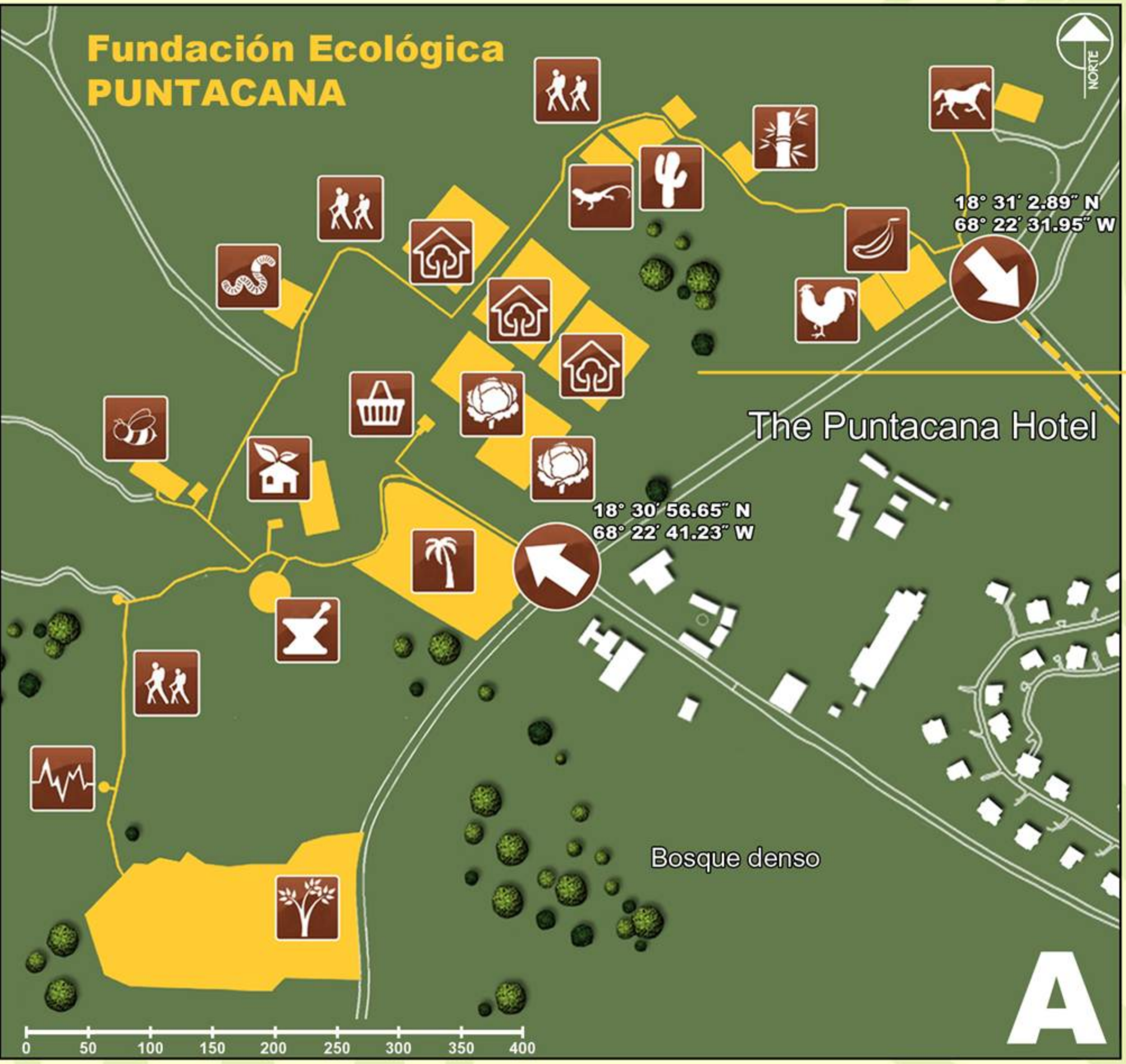
